(See photograph, Plate XXVIJ The verandah is supported in front by six square columns and two pilasters. Each pillar has three brackets, projecting one on each side, and one to the back or inside of the verandah. With one exception all the side brackets are carved with a male and female figure, in different attitudes on each; and each of the brackets, to the inside or roof of the verandah bears a tall female figure. The shoulders of the columns, as in the other caves, are carved with elaborate festoons, c., and on each of the four sides of the lower portions of the shafts are medallions carved with groups of figures. A number, both of the brackets and medallions, have been drawn, but scarcely sufficiently well to do them justice. Photographs...
