The time for toning varies from ten minutes to half an hour, according to the strength of the gold and the temperature of the bath, but the gold should never be strong enough to tone in less than ten minutes, as the hypo would not have time to act, especially if it is an old used bath. The principal advantage of this bath over any other, combined or separate for that matter, is that there is absolutely no danger of bleaching or uneven toning, and any reasonable variation of temperature does not have any injurious...
