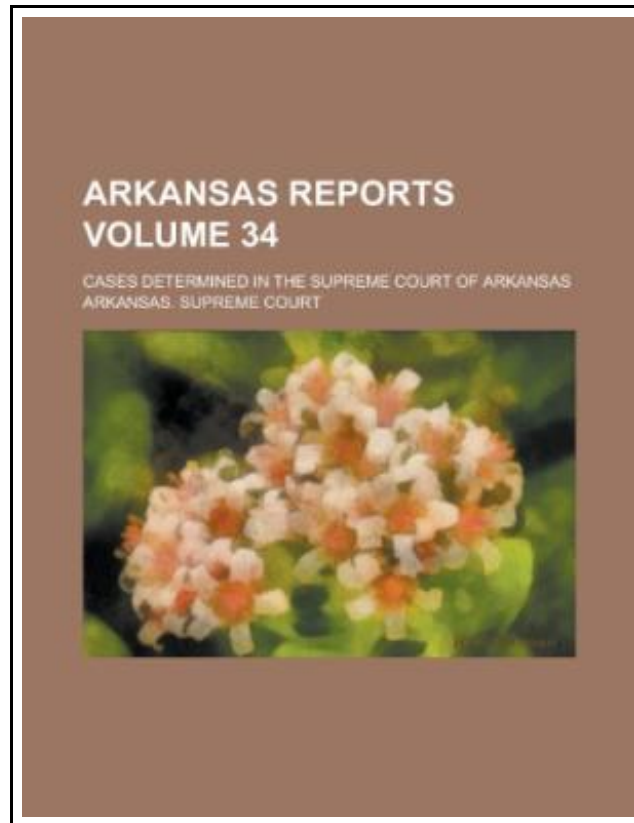

Excerpt: . . . in the proper county where the defendant may reside or have real estate, or where the real estate sought to be affected by the decree or judgment is situated; and the clerk receiving such transcript shall at once file for record, and shall record the same upon his judgment docket; and such judgment or decree shall be a lien upon real estate in the county where the transcript is filed, as if the same had been made or rendered in that county, etc. Moreover, part of the defendants to the original bill resided in Pulaski county--Rust and Martin, Johnsons administrator, and the administration of Johnsons estate, were in that county. This fact alone, had there been no real estate in Pulaski county to be affected in the suit, would, under the law as it then was, have given jurisdiction to the Pulaski chancery court. Hartsook did not originally seek that forum, but was brought there in this suit by due and regular process, and saw fit, as he had the right, to make his answer a cross-bill, that all his rights or supposed rights touching the controversy might be settled in and by that suit.
