Excerpt: . . . to the main ironframes provided for 200-line boards in the same manner used for smaller switchboards. At the main frame the cables are brought through the floor in a position depending on the 20-pair line blocks to which they are assigned. The potheads rest on the floor and are brought up alongside the vertical line of iron braces holding the line blocks to which the cables are connected. The cables to be connected to the top line terminals will naturally be brought in farthest from the bottom block. The potheads should preferably be of same size and height of sleeve and the wires carefully laced and shellacked when formed and in place. T he form should be carried straight up and branched to the blocks at the iron braces, to which they should be neatly fastened by tape. The line blocks number from the...
